Job Overview:

The Lanracorp Operator will be performing routine equipment checks and inspections reporting any issues to a foreman or projects supervisor. Other tasks include loading and unloading equipment, and ensuring sites are kept clean and equipment is safely turned off and secured. You will also observe and work with laborers and complete any required paperwork and reports. An Operator will need to be familiar with and exhibit Lanracorp's Core Values.

To be successful as an Equipment Operator, you should consistently follow health and safety regulations and be able to take instructions from foreman and project supervisors. An outstanding Operator will display great hand and foot coordination and always be thinking of ways to improve efficiency.

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Ensuring all equipment is inspected and used properly.
- Ensuring equipment is properly turned off, loaded, unloaded and secured.
- Training new crew members in the safe operation of equipment.
- Performing other project duties as needed.
- Follow instructions from foreman or Supervisor.
- Promptly reporting all faults to the Foreman or Supervisor.
- Ensuring sites are kept clean and safe.
- Attending meetings and refresher courses to ensure responsible equipment operation.
- Identifying faults and troubleshooting equipment as required.
- Perform site and equipment clean-up.

Qualifications and Requirements:

- Must have a valid driver license, Class A CDL preferred.
- Be at least 18 years of age.
- High school diploma.
- Ability to do physical labor and other strenuous physical tasks.
- Ability to work in all weather.
- Workers must be punctual and reliable.
- Must be willing and available to travel.



- Must be able to do the following physical tasks for up to 12 hours a day:
 - Standing
 - Sitting
 - Operating Foot Controls (Driving, operating heavy machinery, etc.)
 - Walking
 - Bending
 - Twisting
 - Kneeling
 - Grasping
 - Squeezing
 - Reaching Above the Shoulders
 - Pushing & Pulling
 - Lifting up to 75lbs
 - Carrying up to 75lbs
- Must be able to work in the following environments for up to 12 hours a day:
 - Heights
 - Heat Exposure
 - Cold Exposure
 - On Uneven Surfaces

Daily Responsibilities and Duties:

- Follow direction and assigned tasks from Foreman for the day
- Inspection/360 walk around of vehicle before leaving shop or hotel
- Inspection of equipment being operated for the day
- Attend daily Job Site Safety Analysis meeting
- Track all equipment hours and report to Foreman daily with documentation
- Daily activities may include, but are not limited to:
 - Operating hand held power equipment
 - Operating a tracked skid steer w/forestry mulcher, mower, bucket, grapple, stump grinder, landscape rake, etc...
 - Operating a wood chipper
 - Assisting with line locating and GIS cataloging



- o Marking right of way/easement boundaries
- o Moving personnel and equipment from site to site
- Assisting Foreman with project reporting and inspections
- o Site and equipment cleanup
